It is unacceptable to see the Newham residents are forced to pay double Emission Charges!

In 2020, the first car permit was free. In 2023, you are now paying hundreds of pounds for your first, second and third cars in the name of emission charges when your car is already ULEZ compliant. So what difference has your money made to clean the air in Newham? Absolutely no difference! Its is just that Newham Council are taking your money. In 2020/21 the Newham Council robbed its own residents and made £11.85 millions from parking penalties. In 2023, these figures are anticipated to go sky high.


Newham Council Tax Increase
